

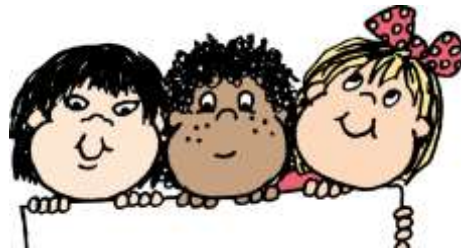
CHILD DEVELOPMENT DAYS SCREENING-2020

Early Educators within the School District of Weyauwega-Fremont will hold the preschool screening this year on Monday, January 20th from 1:00 pm-5:00 pm and Tuesday, January 21st from 8:00 am-12:00 pm at the **Weyauwega Elementary School-GYM, 301 E Ann Street, Weyauwega.** This screening is one of the district's Child Find efforts to provide improved educational opportunities for young children.

Screening is open to all children, ages 2 to 4 1/2, who have not participated in past preschool screenings sponsored by the district. **This screening is essential for enrollment in the Weyauwega-Fremont Four-Year Old Kindergarten Program.**

Children will participate in a play-based screening. The developmental areas of social, self-help, fine motor, gross motor and language will be observed by the early educators within the School District of Weyauwega-Fremont. Parents will have an opportunity to learn about many community agencies including: day cares, preschools, Head Start, libraries, police and fire departments, and public health department. Hearing, vision, and health screenings will also take place by a public health nurse, optometrist and school nurse respectively.

Parents should register their child for an appointment by calling **Molly Fee, 920-867-8821 by January 14, 2020 or Kristin Dolan, 920-867-8053 January 15th- January 17th.** Two questionnaires about your child's growth and development will then be sent to you. We are also sending along a permission form to test your child's vision. The Lion's club will be administering the vision test. They may be completed at home and brought to the screening appointment.
