The Senior Tax Exchange Program allows senior citizens, 62 years of age or older, whose primary residences are in the District and who pay property tax on these residences, to work in their local school. Pay is \$6.50 per hour. Two eligible residents of the same property may share work to meet the \$429 maximum amount for each primary residence, but combined pay may not exceed \$429. This \$429 amounts to a maximum of 66 work hours per household. Compensation will be dispersed via a two-party check made out to the worker and appropriate treasurer in December. The district pays for a Coordinator who is responsible for organizing, managing and scheduling the program as well as the compensation for workers.
